

Adopt-A-Trail Service Program

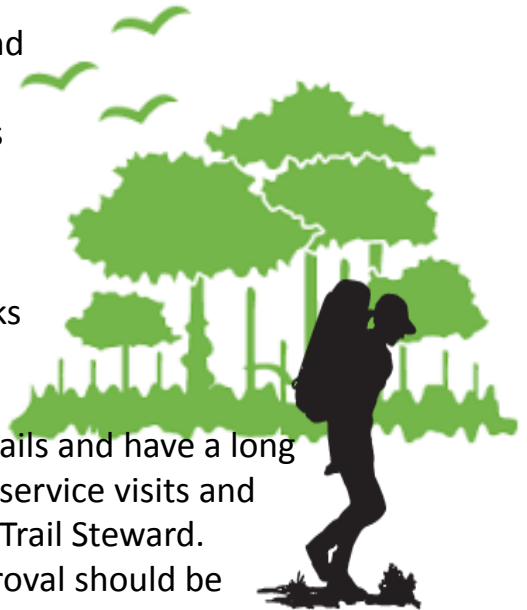


How the Program Works

Register to adopt a 1 mile section of trail at a Circle Ten Council camp
Provide at least 2 service days per year - once in the spring and once in the fall
The Trail Steward will help units identify the work that is needed
The Trail Steward will coordinate necessary tools, materials, and training
Trail sections may not be the same depending on the overall trail "need"
The adoption continues as long as the unit performs the yearly maintenance projects
Special patches will be given to all participants

Common Trail Needs

Clean-up from storm damage - limbs, trees, and trail damage
Erosion repairs and installation of erosion bars
Clearing overgrown or unsafe brush and vegetation
Picking up litter and trash
Maintaining trails markers - signs, blazes, kiosks



What is a Trail Steward?

The Trail Stewards are very familiar with the trails and have a long standing relationship with the ranger staff. All service visits and projects must be pre-approved by the Camps' Trail Steward. Because of the busy camp schedules, this approval should be done at least 30 days before the work day. The Camp Trail Steward will coordinate with the unit contact. The Trail Steward will work with the Rangers to ensure that materials, tools, and safety briefings are ready for the work crew when they arrive.
