

COPE and Climbing Facility Use Policy

The following guidelines are effective immediately regarding the use of any council COPE or Climbing equipment or facilities by district or council activities:

1. The COPE Course and designated campsite must be reserved in addition to other facilities at the Camp. The reservation must be approved by the Project COPE and Climbing Program Manager.
2. A COPE/Climbing Reservation Form must be completed and turned into Camping Reservation or emailed to:

If you need a copy of this form, please email the addresses above.
3. The district/council must provide the appropriate leadership for the activity in accordance with the 2013 Project COPE and Climbing National Standards. If you need assistance, please contact Bryce Backers @ 214.202.2066.
 - The responsible individual must be identified prior to the reservation.
4. Fees:
 - The fee to use the facilities is \$50 per day.
 - The Council COPE/Climbing Committee is NOT responsible for providing a staff for Council and District activities.
