

## Circle Ten Council Training Policy

The following guidelines are effective immediately regarding the use of any council COPE or Climbing equipment or facilities:

1. The Circle Ten Council COPE & Climbing Committee must approve all training courses not facilitated by a State or Nationally recognized organization. In Circle Ten Council, the COPE & Climbing Committee is responsible for issuing cards for the following positions:
  - COPE & Climbing Core Skills Course
  - COPE Facilitator Level I and II
  - Tower Facilitator Level I and II
  - Basic Rock Climbing, Advanced Anchoring
2. Currently the COPE & Climbing Committee Recognizes these courses:
  - Texas Mountaineering Intermediate Class
  - AMGA Climbing Instructor
  - Additional courses will be considered, email [cope-climbing@circle10.org](mailto:cope-climbing@circle10.org) for additional information regarding this process.
3. If a training card from another council or National Camp School is presented, the COPE and Climbing Committee Reserves the right to deny use of council resources until the cardholder can show proficiency.
